
## **WELCOME TO TERM 4**

We have a lot coming up so we are breaking it down into bite sized pieces for you.


- Next Tuesday is our first P&C Meeting for Term 4. We would love to see new faces there

#### **FAQs ABOUT OUR TUCKSHOP**

#### **HOW DO STUDENTS COLLECT THEIR ORDERS?**

Class teachers send a tuckshop monitor to the Snack Shack to collect their class' tuckshop basket. These are usually taken back to class or the eating area and students should go to the basket to collect their orders. Prep orders are taken to their precinct.

### WHAT HAPPENS IF A STUDENT CANNOT FIND THEIR ORDER?

They should speak with the Teacher on Duty (TOD) in the first instance. The TOD may ask the student to check other class baskets or send them to the Snack Shack to double check with tuckshop staff.

## MY STUDENT IS AWAY/HAS GONE HOME EARLY AND WON'T NEED THEIR TUCKSHOP - WHAT SHOULD I DO?

Please contact the tuckshop staff via phone (3863 9117) to advise them before 9am. Orders that are not prepared can be kept for another day. If the order has been prepared, you can come to the tuckshop to collect at the relevant break.

#### FORGOTTEN LUNCH/LATE ORDERS

Parents can order a LATE ORDER LUNCH from Flexischools until 9.30am. If a student forgets their lunch, they should advise the teacher or school office. The school will then contact parents to gain permission to provide the student with a lunch from the Snack Shack. An invoice will be sent home for the student's meal, which can be paid for directly via direct deposit or through "MONEY I OWE" feature in Flexischools.
