The 'Idea Book' supports the National Quality Framework Standard 1.1 An approved learning framework informs the development of a curriculum that enhances each child's learning and development.

Evidence for Standard 1.1 (Rating and Assessment Aspley October 2015)

Programs were planned to respond to the diverse knowledge, ideas, culture, interests and abilities of children based on information gathered from a variety of sources, including families. Educators demonstrated flexibility in program delivery, responding to and incorporating children's ideas and interests by providing extended periods of uninterrupted play allowing children to discover, create, improvise, imagine and enjoy 'being'. Documentation sighted and discussions with educators and the Nominated Supervisor (NS) indicated that both the before and after school programs and Holiday Club (vacation care) are planned to respond to children's current needs, interests and abilities.
