Our athletics carnival are all about two things, participation, and the selection for our Aspley State School team, who compete in the North District trials. The days are planned around these two concepts.

We encourage all students to compete and have a go by building a sense of house spirit. With potentially 409 students participating and only a handful winning age champion medals it is important we support and foster personal effort and participation of each student.

Parents / carers are invited to attend the days and must sign in to the school visitor's register. Parents / carers are to maintain a respectful distance from the events, finish lines and judges in order for them to carry out their duties.

If you wish to make a protest for any event, please complete a *Protest Form* to advise the judge of your concern. Judges will consider each case and their decisions are final. We are a primary school sports day and endeavour to make the experience fun and fair for all.

Competitors are randomly placed into House teams (Oxley, Kennedy and Mitchell) to compete against students of the same age group.

Trophies are awarded for:

- Ball Games and
- Overall House Points.

Trophies will be awarded at the end of the carnival, provided results have been finalised and authorised by the judges.

Points system:

Points will be awarded for participation in all track events and field events as follows:

1 st – 10pts	2 nd – 9pts	3 rd – 8pts	4 th – 7pts
5 th – 6pts	6 th – 5pts	7 th – 5pts	8 th – 4pts

Students who participate in an events- 1pts

Divisional Winner	-	Based on points in finals only (A, B and C school winners)
Aggregate	-	Based on overall points for the 2 days of competition
Percentage	-	Based on overall points divided by enrolment numbers
Age champion	-	Based on highest points overall all in age group and gender
		1 st , 2 nd , 3 rd place getting receive a ribbon

Program

We will be using *Meet Manager* software to score and calculate the overall house points. This software seeds the races and events.

Nominations

Students are expected to 'have a go' at all the events in the spirit of team competition. We encourage parents to support their child to participate and demonstrate good sportsmanship.

Track events

80m (8yrs and 9 yrs.) - Heats/Semi/finals-

Progression:

Random seeding

Top 2 out of each heat when there is 6 heats progress to the semi

Top 3 out of each heat when there is 4 heats progress to the semi

Top 3 out of the first heat then top 2 when there is 5 heats.

The Final will be made up with 12 competitors

No progression to district trial

100m (10-12yrs)-Heats/Semis/finals

Random seeding

Progression: Top 2 out of each heat when there is 6 heats

Top 3 out of the fastest heat the 1st and 2nd in the next heat

Top 3 out of each heat 4 heats.

Finals will have 12 competitors

The top 2 in each age group and gender will progress to North District trial from the final.

200m (8yrs -9yrs) Heats/finals

Random seeding

Top 6 fastest times progress to finals

Top 2 in each age group and gender progress to District trial

400m (8-9yrs)

Pre carnival event timed heat randomly seeded self-nominated

Top 6 Fastest times progress to the final

Timed finals no progression

800m (10-12yrs) pre carnival heat/timed final

Pre carnival event timed heat randomly seeded self-nominated

Top 6 fastest time progress to final.

Top 2 in each age group and gender progress to the district carnival.

1500m (10-12yrs) pre carnival event, randomly seeded and timed final.

Top 2 in each age group and gender progress to district carnival.

Field events

In the event of a tie, after the appropriate countback rules have been applied, no Jump/throw off will be conducted to separate medal places.

Discus (10-12)

Pre carnival event

10 yrs. - 500g

11 & 12yrs - 750g

1st and 2nd in each age group and gender progress to the district trial.

Long Jump (8-12)

8-9 yrs. No progression to district event

10-12 yrs.

1st and 2nd in 10-12 age groups and gender progress to district event.

High Jump (8-12 yrs.)

Selection criteria

Placed 1st or 2nd in any 3 of the nominated event (100,800,shot put,long jump.)

1 competitor per 10-12 yrs. age group per gender progress to the district event.
