Student Nominations and Trials:

• 800m / 1500m: All students are eligible (students self-nominated)

• **Discus:** all students are eligible (students determined through class lessons)

- **High Jump / Shotput / Long-jump:** All students are eligible for these events. The top students, per age group, will qualify for the finals on sports day. This selection was determined through class lessons. The number of top students can vary depending on the size of the cohort and the qualifying distances from class lesson qualifying event.
 - All other students, not selected for the finals, will participate in the same event, which does not contribute to aggregate points. These students will not be eligible for the finals and will not gain points towards age championship.
- **Ball Games:** All students are eligible and are strongly encouraged to participate.
- **Circular Relays:** All students are eligible. Trials are held prior to the carnival to decide each houses relay teams. Trials are held in year levels, not ages e.g.: Year 3,4,5,6.

- **Finalist High Jump:** First rise of 10cm, second rise 5cm or 10cm depending on numbers and abilities of competitors left, third rise 3cm or 5cm. Students will be given 3 attempts at all heights for the finalists).
- After the Aspley State School Track and Field Carnival, the students selected to compete at the District level, for the 100m event, will be timed at a track outside the school, at a date to be advised. A note will be provided to the qualifying students to advise of further details.
