When I structure my art lessons I always consider the importance of the creative process. The most Important rule for guiding children's art activities is that the process is always more important than the product. "Process" means allowing children to explore art materials with freedom without the pressure to stay in the lines. Process is experimenting with paints, watching the mixing colours, and feeling the textures of more or less. Process is gluing various sizes, shapes, and colours of paper together to create a collage. Process is freedom to experiment and enjoy the feeling of creating without being concerned with the outcome or the product.

According to the World Economic Forum's The Future of Jobs Report, 'creativity' will be one of the top three skills required to thrive in 2020. This is a profound prediction when understanding why the creative arts are important in education.

We need to equip the next generation with the skills required to succeed in a workforce that experts are predicting will look startlingly different to today's job market. Within the next three years it is said that a 'Fourth Industrial Revolution' will result in massive advances in robotics, artificial intelligence and biotechnology.
