- ➤ Parents and Citizens' Association (P&C) exists to promote the school's interests, facilitate the school's development and contribute to the school's improvement.
- A P&C is a group of people who take a formal role in supporting a school by enabling and providing:
 - close cooperation between parents, community, staff and students
 - feedback on school policies and activities
 - resources to enhance student learning and improve the school environment (often by raising funds)
 - opportunities for parents to be involved in their child's education and the broader school community

Dear Aspley State School Community

Aspley SS P&C Association invites you to play a greater volunteer role in our school community. We are a volunteer-led organisation, that requires **your** involvement. Our P&C provides support to the school by managing business operations such as the Tuckshop and Uniform Shop, helping parents connect, and providing students and families with a variety of FUN activities. Any funds raised from these events are returned to the school and used for a variety of projects including playground upgrades and classroom refurbishment. We also provide feedback to the school leadership team through our general meetings held twice per term (check the newsletter for dates – usually a Tuesday night at 7pm in the library); as well as parent representation on the School Council.

In 2020, we will need volunteers in the following roles:

- **President**: provides leadership and representation for the P&C and its Executive.
- **Vice President**: supports the President by chairing meetings in the President's absence, attending to tasks as delegated, and assists other members of the executive.
- **Treasurer**: has overall responsibility for the financial management of the P&C, including all subcommittee accounts.
- Secretary: provides administrative support to the P&C, including recording the minutes of
 meetings, attending to all correspondence to and from the P&C, and keeping the P&C's
 documents safe and in good order.
- Aspley Spirit Network: 2 to 3 people from each year level who will provide feedback from their year level, but also share P&C information with the greater parent community.
- **Event Organisers**: We require two or three parents who would like to work together to manage ONE of the following events in 2020. You will be given support as required.
 - Easter Bake Stall
 - Sponsorship Drive
 - Trivia Night (Adults event)
 - School Disco
 - Mother's & Father's Day Stall
 - o Sausage Sizzles (two elections, 2 sports days in 2020)

Our P&C tries to limit our paper notes that we send home, so we use the electronic school newsletter (under 'P&C News'), Facebook and opt-in emails, to keep families in the know.
